Responsibilities

Your tasks includes namely :

- Implementation of projects:
 - Prepare future installations in lab environment
 - Installation and commissioning of the solution at the customers site
 - User and Administrator training sessions.
 - Identify, log, describe, escalate and follow up until resolution all issues arising during project implementation.
 - Documentation of the installation (As-built).
- Act as technical focal point towards the customer : listen, understand and communicate with the client regarding his “wishes/ requirements” and report towards your colleagues.
- Perform upgrades and extensions on existing installations
- Interact with the R&D team on the design, built and tests (functional/performance) of new functional blocks.
- Act as technical PM for “small” projects where no dedicated PM is defined.
- Independent site survey and analysis of the customer requirements; detection report and documentation of the potential risks towards PM.
- Design solutions based on measurement statement.

- Preparation measurement statement.
- Manage subcontractor onsite.
- Technical ownership.
- Report progress planning project/subproject.
- Engineering the solution with regard to the necessary products – hardware and software; calculation of products and services.
- Manage technical issues, assure they are followed up and if necessary escalate within the suppliers organization until resolution.
- **Maintenance**
 - Execute first and second line corrective maintenance
 - Execute preventive visits
 - Follow up of reparations of defect material
 - Update site documentation after intervention (software release, installed base...).
- **Non project based**
 - Participate in tests setups required for demo, exposition and/or product validation.
